RESPONSIBILITIES:

Accountable for development, implementation, and training of SHE programs and projects for the Coating Facilities in Santa Fe Springs / Whittier and Placentia CA. Provide advice to operations and subsidiary manufacturers of our chemical products to ensure compliance with EPA, OSHA, DOT, local, state, and industrial standards. Act as the global liaison between the Coatings Technical organization and the regional SHE organizations for the production of Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) having access to all related software programs within each region for the production of MSDS's.

- With the assistance of plant personnel and management, develop, implement, and audit SHE programs and policies.
- Conduct required regulatory SHE training including but not limited to: new hire orientation, HAZCOM, PPE, SWPPP, SPCC, confined space entry, lock-tag-try, hearing conservation, ergonomics, powered industrial vehicles, electrical safety, NFPA 70E, blood-borne pathogens, respiratory protection, DOT, RCRA, CalOSHA, CalEPA, etc.
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date measurement, recordkeeping and reporting processes, including but not limited to OSHA (CalOSHA) recordkeeping, environmental calendar, regulatory agency reporting, corporate reporting, key measures reporting, etc.
- Pursue ISO 14001 certification and serve as the management systems representative for the certified systems.
- Secure and maintain all pertinent environmental permits, programs, reporting, and inspection documentation.
- Provide urgent response to operational issues 24/7 which includes injuries, near misses, environmental upset conditions, etc. Must obtain Incident Commander training or 40-hour HAZWOPER certification.
- Develop and implement a behavior-based safety process for operations.
- Work with the site R & D lab to maintain chemical inventories, MSDS management and authoring through our software system, and development and maintenance of a chemical hygiene plan.
- Review new raw materials to ensure compliance with global regulations.
- Maintain current knowledge of global regulations and serve as regulatory advisor to R&D group.
- Work collaboratively with Global SHE to ensure compliance of Product formulations.
- File required documentation to ensure availability of a current MSDS.
- Work collaboratively with corporate SHE to ensure that WERCS database is current.

- Serve as local regulatory “expert “ for coatings and operations group.
- Maintain a raw material information database for all raw materials used in coatings applications.
- Obtain “Global Raw Material Codes” for all coatings raw materials.
- Provide regulatory information on coating products to customer as requested by the customer.
- Enter coating formulas in JDE and Formulator.
- Prepare US & Europe MSDS’s using WERCS working with all Regional Safety, Health & Environmental groups.
- Monitor the North American Coatings MSDS database to ensure it is current.
- Interface with government regulatory agencies as needed.
- Maintain WERCS regulatory database for coatings.

EDUCATIION / EXPERIENCE:

- BS degree in engineering, environmental sciences, environmental/safety management or related discipline is required or equivalent experience.
- Four to seven years related SHE experience, preferably with multiple site experience.
- Experience with California regulations.
- The Safety & Environmental Specialist will have a proven track record and demonstrated success in interfacing with all levels of the organization. Solid judgment, technical insight and pragmatic strategic vision are also essential, as are strong presentation skills and a high sense of urgency to meet all commitments.
- Must be a team player with effective verbal and written communication skills.
- Must have the ability to execute projects and directives efficiently.
- Experience with incident investigations using root-cause analysis tools such as TapRoot® or 5-Why Analysis.
- Computer proficiency in MS Office required.
